
Church of the Holy Trinity, Bosham, West Sussex.

Clockwise from top left, this page -

- 1. SW quoins, tower; note the Roman tooling on these reused stone blocks.
- 2. North face of tower.
- 3. Topmost window opening, tower, west face, note shaft mid-way in wall thickness.


Bosham Church.

Clockwise from top left, this page -

- 1. Chancel arch viewed from the nave.
- 2. Chancel arch, north capital viewed from the chancel.
- 3. Chancel arch north capital, from below. Possible re-use of Roman stonework (reuse of Roman stone detail being common and in this case possibly ex. the nearby Fishbourne Roman Palace).
- 4. Archway to tower, situated in east wall of tower, viewed from nave.
