3. East tower archway, viewed from the east, in nave (nave is set to the east of the tower). This archway is different in detail, and larger, compared to its western sister (see page 1) and shows signs of heavy repair (in places) in plaster. Date, possibly transitional Saxo-Norman.
4. The arched opening in the east wall of the tower (seen from the nave) and situate above the arch in photo 1.
